

The adoption and objectives




- The Strategy was adopted on 1 September 2011 by the Swedish Government. The Ministers of Enterprise and Energy, Environment, Trade and Development have the lead.
- The objective of the Strategy is to improve the conditions for the development and deployment of environmental technologies and solutions.
- The Strategy aims to improve the co-ordination between different government bodies working with supporting environmental technology. Support the best institutional framework.
- Total 400 MSEK 2011-2014 (€46M) on new initiatives from research&innovation, to commercialisation, to internationalisation.
- Initiative <u>additional</u> to already ongoing activities to support the development of environmental technology – RD&D, energy and carbon taxes, green certificate system, environmental protection legislation, trade promotion, international development assistance etc.
